Frequently asked questions about Cherrypine™



Question;

What is Cherrypine™?

Answer;

Cherrypine is timber that has been treated using a colourant system which was developed by Osmose® using the MicroPro™ technology. This technology micronises colour pigment to a size that allows it to penetrate the timber under pressure.

Question;

What colour is it?

Answer;

Cherrypine is a red/brown, similar to darker coloured Australian hardwoods.

Question;

How consistent is the colour?

Answer;

The colour is uniform however Cherrypine will not hide any of the natural characteristics and beauty of wood such as timber grain.

Question;

Does the 'colourant system' have any impact on the preservative system?

Answer;

No. The active ingredients of the preservative system are not affected.

Question;

Does the 'colourant system' affect the structural properties of Cherrypine timber?

Answer;

No. There is no impact on the structural properties of the timber.

Question;

What maintenance is required for Cherrypine timber?

Answer;

No specific maintenance is required however we do recommend that a weather resistant finish or decking oil be applied to provide some protection from normal weathering.

Question;

Can I refresh the colour if it does weather?

Answer;

Yes. A matching or similar colored stain could be applied to the timber when required. Always follow the advice of the paint manufacturer.

Question;

Does Cherrypine have an odour?

Answer;

No.
